Provides uterine massages, assess the amount of lochia, administer intravenous oxytocin and other drugs, give care to patients with PPH, rule out hematomas, assist mothers in skin to skin contact and breastfeeding.
Please indicate your level of competency Post-Partum Care - new born	1			More than 400	I usually do newborn care after completing skin to skin contact. Does head to toe examination, check for any abnormal findings and informs paediatricians for further assessment
